MINNESOTA/DAKOTAS

In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$3,212,900** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Minnesota/Dakotas Parkinson's Disease (PD) Community**.



IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **1,040** health professionals
- Offered help through **1,780** calls to our Helpline
- Distributed **70,430** free publications in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(Struthers Parkinson's Center)

Treated **2,070** people at our Centers of Excellence

325 enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD

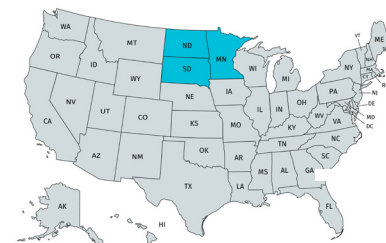


RESEARCH

- **6** researchers received grants totaling **\$126,000**
- **30** research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective

17,430

which equals **\$871.5 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in the Minnesota/Dakotas Chapter



EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **2,890** **Aware in Care** kits prepared people for the hospital
- **2,000** people participated in educational programs
- **640** people received free services through over 600 community grants totaling **\$641,940**
- **7,100** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$1.6 million** through Moving Day
