In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$71,900** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Alabama Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



## Improving Care

- Trained **805 health professionals**
- Offered help through **730 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **2,790 free publications** in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500 people nationally** at our Centers of Excellence

**13,000 people** enrolled nationally in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



## Research

- **2 researchers** received grants totaling **\$45,000**



## Education and Empowerment

- **970 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **85 people** received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$26,900**
- **780 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$152,000** through Moving Day

**11,980** people with PD in Alabama

which equals **\$599 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in AL
