ARIZONA

In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$412,700** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Arizona Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **370 health professionals**
- Offered help through **1,305 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **19,365 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(Barrow Neurological Institute)

135 people enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



RESEARCH

- **2 researchers** received grants totaling **\$19,500**
- **22 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective



EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **1,660 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **200 people** participated in educational programs
- **440 people** received free services through 4 community grants totaling **\$55,000**
- **400 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$73,500** through Moving Day
