ARKANSAS

In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$121,000** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Arkansas PD Community**.



IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **760 health professionals**
- Offered help through **380 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **1,860 free publications** in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500 people nationally** at our Centers of Excellence

15 enrolled in AR in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD



RESEARCH

- **1 researcher** received grants totaling **\$100,000**



EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **630 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **45 people** received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$21,000**
- **1,145 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$252,000** through Moving Day

7,490 people with PD in Arkansas

which equals **\$375 Million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in AR
