In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$85,000** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Colorado Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



## Improving Care

- Trained **140 health professionals**
- Offered help through **860 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **6,010 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence** .....  
*(University of Colorado Movement Disorders Center)*

**Treated 7,040 people at our Center of Excellence**

**13,000 people enrolled nationally in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD**



## Research

- **1 researcher** received a grant totaling **\$4,000**



## Education and Empowerment

- **530 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **1,200 people** received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$21,000**

**11,540** people with PD in Colorado

which equals **\$577 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in CO
