- Trained **1,170** health professionals

- Distributed **33,720** free publications in English and Spanish

Treated **0,015** people at our Centers of Excellence

## RESEARCH

- **8** researchers received grants totaling **\$311,200**
- **30** research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective



## EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **2,590** Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital
- **HDT** people participated educational programs
- **MCTT** people received free services through 10 community grants totaling **\$87,300**
- **3,035** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$693,000** through Moving Day
