In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$3,364,700** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Florida Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



Improving Care

- Trained **1,080** health professionals
- Offered help through **8,225** calls to our Helpline
- Distributed **72,030** free publications in English and Spanish
- Funded **three Centers of Excellence**

(Miller School of Medicine, University of Miami | University of Florida Center for Movement Disorders and Neurorestoration | University of South Florida Parkinson's Disease and Movement Disorders Center)

Treated **11,780** people at our Centers of Excellence

820 people enrolled in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD



Research

- **7** researchers and **1** research center (University of Florida in collaboration with Emory University) received grants totaling **\$763,400**
- **25** research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective



Education and Empowerment

- **5,230** Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital
- **3,210** people participated in educational programs
- **8,140** people received free services through **64** community grants totaling **\$774,500**
- **17,290** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$5,082,200** through Moving Day
