In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$76,100** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Indiana Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



## Improving Care

- Trained **175 health professionals**
- Offered help through **1,055 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **11,790 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence** .....  
*(Indiana University School of Medicine)*

Treated **2,000** people at our Center of Excellence

**35** people enrolled in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD

- **1** researcher received a grant totaling **\$4,000**



## Education and Empowerment

- **715** Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital
- **110** people received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$12,100**
- **\$4,800** raised through our Community Walks program
