In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$68,900** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Iowa Parkinson's disease (PD) Community**.



Improving Care

- Trained **215 health professionals**
- Offered help through **380 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **4,850 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(University of Iowa)

Treated **1,000 people** at our **Center of Excellence**

13,000 people enrolled nationally in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



Education and Empowerment

- **315 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **50 people** received free services through one community grant totaling **\$8,900**
- **\$6,000** raised through our Community Walks program

8,280 people with PD in Iowa

which equals **\$414 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in IA
