In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$19,100** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Louisiana PD Community**.



## IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **405 health professionals**
- Offered help through **250 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **6,170 free publications** in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500** people **nationally** at our Centers of Excellence

**30** enrolled in LA in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD



## EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **625 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **110 people** received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$19,100**.
- **270 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$49,100** through Moving Day
