In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$1,210,000** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Minnesota Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



Improving Care

- Trained **980 health professionals**
- Offered help through **1,600 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **68,170 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(Struthers Parkinson's Center)

Treated **2,070 people** at our **Center of Excellence**

325 people enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



Research

- **6 researchers** received grants totaling **\$126,000**
- **30 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective



Education and Empowerment

- **2,870 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **1,740 people** participated educational programs
- **10,760 people** received free services through **670** community grants totaling **\$622,940**
- **6,950 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$1,562,500** through Moving Day

13,380 people with PD in Minnesota

which equals **\$669 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in MN
