- Trained **185** health professional
- Offered help through **235** calls to our Helpline
- Distributed **4,220** free publications in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500** people nationally at our Centers of Excellence

5 enrolled in NE in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD



EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **245** Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital
- **40** people received free services through one community grant totaling **\$7,000**
- **285** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$51,000** through Moving Day

4,610 people with PD in Nebraska

which equals **\$231 Million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in NE
