In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$19,000** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Nevada Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



Improving Care

- Trained **115 health professionals**
- Offered help through **420 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **3,900 free publications** in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500 people nationally** at our **Centers of Excellence**

13,000 people enrolled nationally in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



Education and Empowerment

- **225 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **30 people** received free services through one community grant totaling **\$19,000**
- **420 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$52,500** through Moving Day

6,670 people with PD in Nevada

which equals **\$333 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in NV
