- Trained **105 health professionals**
- Offered help through **360 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **4,170 free publications** in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500 people nationally** at our Centers of Excellence

**13,000 people enrolled nationally** in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD

## Education and Empowerment



- **270 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **50 people** received free services through one community grant totaling **\$10,000**
- **170 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$26,700** through Moving Day

**5,270** people with PD in New Mexico

which equals **\$263 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in NM
