## RESEARCH

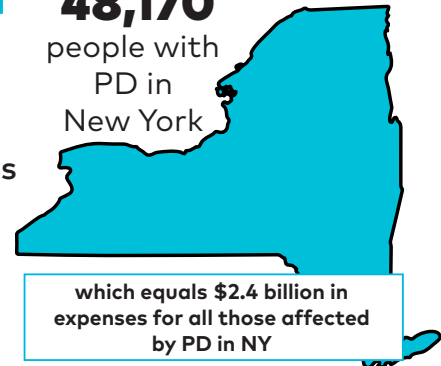
- **17** researchers and **1** research center (Columbia University Irving Medical Center) received grants totaling **\$2,152,300**
- **50** research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective



## EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **2,110** Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital
- **2,150** people participated in educational programs
- **2,135** people received free services through 7 community grants totaling **\$124,500**
- **5,365** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$1,221,800** through Moving Day
