## Improving Care



- Trained **60 health professionals**
- Offered help through **25 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **2,260 free publications** in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500 people nationally** at our Centers of Excellence

**13,000 people** enrolled **nationally** in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD

## Education and Empowerment



- **300 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **260 people** participated in educational programs
- **75 people** received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$19,000**
- **155 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$36,000** through Moving Day

**1,810** people with PD in North Dakota

which equals **\$91 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in ND
