In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$205,000** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Ohio Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.

Improving Care

- Trained **1,190 health professionals**
- Offered help through **2,710 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **51,210 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(Cleveland Clinic Ohio)

Treated **5,300 people** at our **Center of Excellence**

10 people enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



Research

- **3 researchers** received grants totaling **\$17,400**
- **20 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective



Education and Empowerment

- **3,065 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **2,060 people** participated in educational programs
- **520 people** received free services through 5 community grants totaling **\$67,600**
- **5,750 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$1,595,180** through Moving Day
