Improving Care

- Trained **1,365 health professionals**
- Offered help through **2,970 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **34,940 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **two Centers of Excellence**

235 people enrolled in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD




Research

- **11 researchers** received grants totaling **\$568,300**
- **30 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective



Education and Empowerment

- **1,860 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **125 people** received free services through 3 community grants totaling **\$45,700**
- **415 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$75,100** through Moving Day
