- Trained **90** health professionals
- Offered help through **140** calls to our Helpline
- Distributed **650** free publications in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500** people nationally at our Centers of Excellence

13,000 people enrolled nationally in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD

Education and Empowerment



- **110** **Aware in Care** kits prepared people for the hospital
- **300** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$81,000** through Moving Day

2,790 people with PD in Rhode Island

which equals **\$140** million in expenses for all those affected by PD in RI
