## Improving Care

- Trained **180 health professionals**
- Offered help through **855 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **13,100 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence** .....  
*(Medical University of South Carolina)*

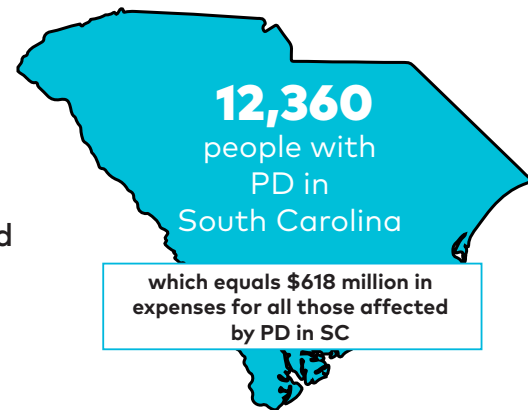
Treated **3,950** people at our Center of Excellence

**125 people** enrolled in SC in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD



## Education and Empowerment

- **420 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **195 people** received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$40,900**
- **950 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$295,100** through Moving Day
