In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$100,900** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **South Carolina Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



Improving Care

- Trained **180 health professionals**
- Offered help through **855 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **13,100 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(Medical University of South Carolina)

Treated **3,950 people** at our **Center of Excellence**

125 people enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



Education and Empowerment

- **420 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **195 people** received free services through 2 community grants totaling **\$40,900**
- **950 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$295,100** through Moving Day

12,360 people with PD in South Carolina

which equals **\$618 million** in expenses for all those affected by PD in SC
