In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$456,000** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Tennessee Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



Improving Care

- Trained **330 health professionals**
- Offered help through **1,165 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **16,430 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence**
(Vanderbilt University Medical Center)

Treated **3,165 people** at our **Center of Excellence**

255 people enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



Research

- **5 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective



Education and Empowerment

- **765 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **365 people** participated in educational programs
- **1,975 people** received free services through 5 community grants totaling **\$42,000**
- **1,350 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$293,400** through Moving Day
