TEXAS

In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$961,200** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Texas Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



## IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **2,755 health professionals**
- Offered help through **3,210 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **26,630 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **one Center of Excellence** .....  
*(Baylor College of Medicine)*

Treated **3,100** people at our **Center of Excellence**

**435** people enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD



## RESEARCH

- **5 researchers** received grants totaling **\$412,670**
- **30 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective



## EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **2,005 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **3,350 people** received free services through **8** community grants totaling **\$130,000**
- **610 people** participated in educational programs
- **2,845 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$515,390** through Moving Day
