WASHINGTON

In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$473,000** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **Washington Parkinson's disease (PD) community**.



IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **430 health professionals**
- Offered help through **875 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **6,650 free publications** in English and Spanish

Treated **193,500 people nationally** at our Centers of Excellence

40 people enrolled in WA the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD



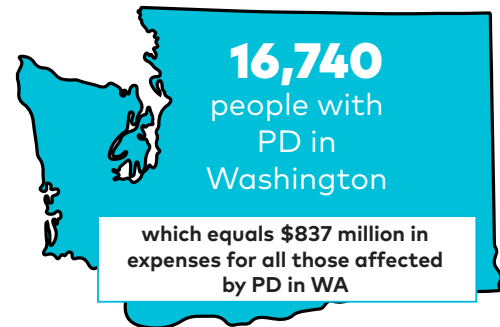
RESEARCH

- **8 researchers** received grants totaling **\$462,000**
- **15 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective



EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **615 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **30 people** received free services through 1 community grant totaling **\$11,000**
