2. You will be sent an invitation link soon to reserve your arrival time through Eventbrite.
3. Decorate your car to show off your Parkinson's Pride, then show up at Winter Growth in Columbia at your reserved time, ready for fun!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What will the Moving Day Drive-Thru event look like?

Participants will be invited to drive through a decorated route filled with fun, interactive, family-friendly activities. The event will put our community's energy on full display as we return to celebrating together. This 15-20 minute experience will include live music, Parkinson's education, movement activities, community resources, rewards pickup, and much more. You don't want to miss it!

Q. Will the event be safe?

Our priority is to bring our community back together while continuing to keep everyone safe. We are closely following all CDC and Howard County Health Department safety guidelines. Event personnel will be wearing protective equipment, and physical distancing practices will be enforced to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

Q. Will there be remote participation options?

If attending the drive-thru isn't for you, we invite you to join us on Saturday, May 22, at Virtual Moving Day – an engaging, inspiring and interactive digital experience! We will share more details soon.

Q. Will I need to wear a mask?

Since there will be multiple opportunities to receive fun prizes and interact through your vehicle's windows, the Maryland Health Department requires that all attendees and volunteers wear a mask at all times.

Q. Will I be able to get out of my vehicle?

At this time, the Maryland Health Department requires that all participants stay in their vehicles at all times except to use the restroom.

Q. Will there be an actual "Walk" this year?
